Preparation - preparing students for work to come and allowing them the opportunity to prepare for this ahead of lesson time

Personal development - the completion of homework helps students to develop their independence, timekeeping and show them the
 importance of good work ethic

Parent-child relationships - the completion of work at home helps parents and children to bond and develop their relationship through home-learning support

Parent-teacher communication - homework acts as the bridge between home and school, the setting of homework and parents being aware of when it's set helps to improve communication between home and school


Peer interactions - when students are set group assignments as homework it encourages them to interact with their peers and work together

Policy - homework set is inline with the school's policy ensuring students aren't overburdened with work and teachers set work in adherence to
 this policy
