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### Increasing Quantity and Quality of Homework

Keeping students engaged during distance learning

Beaumont Leys School is a secondary school in Leicester which caters for students aged between 11 and 16. The school has one of Leicester's four Learning Support Units and one of two City Learning Centres. The school's ethos states that they "have high expectations for what every student and teacher can achieve". Their goal is to create a community feel that encourages excellence - academically and in the development of broader life skills.

# How did you use Satchel One during the national lockdown to continue teaching and learning?

We started uploading narrated PowerPoint presentations to go with the work we were already setting on Satchel One. The Submission Status Report allowed us to track if students were engaging with the work.
