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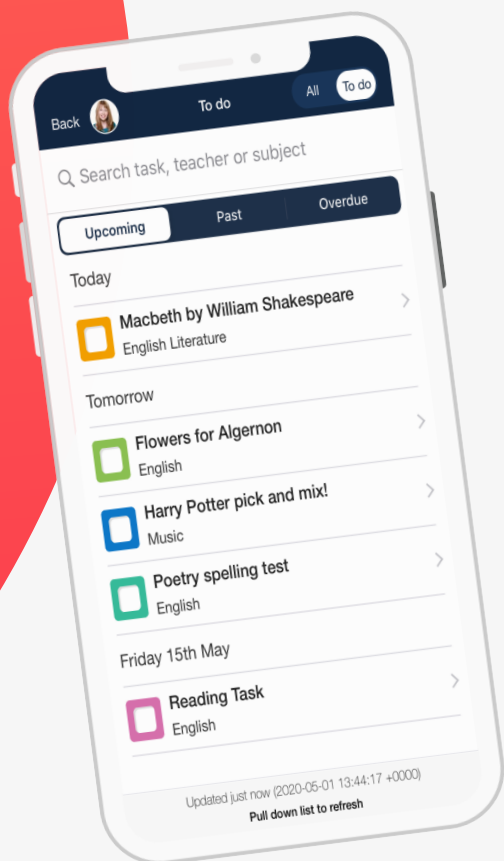

Greg Lindley's Customer Success Story

My name is Greg Lindley and I am an Assistant Headteacher at Holy Cross Catholic High School in Chorley. At Holy Cross we strive to develop resilient, independent learners who take an active interest in their own learning. The setting of homework, and in particular, the introduction of the online software, Satchel One, has helped to promote these characteristics in our pupils.

Prior to Satchel One we were experiencing the same issues with homework - pupils across both key stages were inconsistently using their homework diaries, and we often found that pupils were not writing down sufficient details in order for them to complete homework to a high quality.

There were also numerous examples of homework being lost and pupils who had been absent from school being unable to access homework that had been set whilst they were away. Satchel One solves all of these problems.



The software is very easy to use and the Satchel One team was extremely helpful during its implementation. Within a couple of weeks of launching all staff were using Satchel One to set their homework. Collaboration amongst colleagues has also increased, with members of staff frequently sharing resources that they have uploaded to the site.

Monitoring the quality and quantity of homework set across the school was once an arduous and time consuming task. Using this system I am able to perform such a task in literally minutes.

Our parents are also very complimentary on how useful the system is for monitoring the homework that their child has received, and the deadlines that have been set.
