Streamlined communication

Throughout the pandemic, Satchel One was my primary means of communication with pupils and families and has provided a quick and easy way to relay information home. At first it was just a means of getting the work to pupils, but as time went on and my confidence grew using the platform, I realised there was far more to it.

I have been able to set work for the children with all necessary documents attached, including video and web links for all tasks, as well as adding hyperlinks to task descriptions.

Staying connected

I love the Homework Discussion feature as it allows me to monitor and engage with pupils around school work easily. I encouraged my learners to use this feature during the pandemic to ask each other questions if they were stuck on a task, as a means of peer support. 
Sharing best practice
