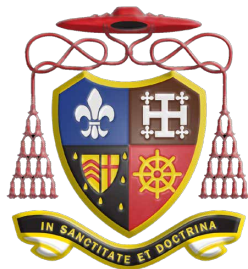


The Power of Parental Involvement

Satchel One is a popular and useful online tool used in schools and homes to accommodate the needs of students and teachers, but one of its most highly praised features is its parental accessibility.

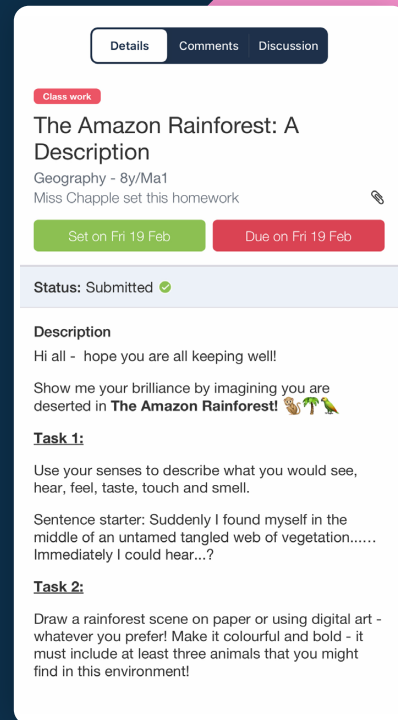
Satchel One can be accessed from any device, thanks to the app, whether you're a teacher, student or parent, the functionality remains as useful as ever.
