- **Adverse weather conditions**



1. View your child's assigned work

Show My Homework offers parents complete visibility around the work their child is set. There are a number of ways you can see what work your child has been assigned:


- **To-do list**

Your children have their own personal To-do List whereby any tasks assigned to them will appear in order of due date. You have a full view of your child's To-do List so you know what tasks they have been assigned and which are due first.



- **Notifications**

Whenever your child is issued a piece of homework, you will receive a notification on the mobile app so you're always in the loop. Search Satchel One in the app store to download the app.



2. Provide support

If your child is spending full days in your home working on schoolwork, it's important you have enough information about the tasks at hand to try and offer support if they need it.

It's for this reason with Show My Homework, you have a full view of all information and assignments set to your child - including due date, description, how long it should take, how to submit it and any additional resources from the teacher. 
